## **Look for Opportunities**

O Is there anyone in your group with whom you do not have a good connection? What can you do to strengthen your relationship?
O Is there anyone in your group that has dropped off in attendance or seems to be giving up? How could you be encouraging?

• Who has been the most faithful in your group? How can you be commending?
O Is there anyone you have not had a spiritual conversation with? Will you pray for the opportunity?
• Which group member are you least drawn to? What can you pray for this person and yourself?
O Who in your group might not know Christ? Have you carefully reflected on their responses? Does God want you to share the Gospel?
• What do you need to ask God to help you with to become a better mentor and shepherd?
O Have you prayed to identify potential leaders for next year? Who has untapped leadership potential?
